Conosciuta anche come Fonte delle Sese, risale al XIX secolo e in passato era frequentata soprattutto dalle donne del posto che erano solite bagnarsi i seni e fare offerte votive perché si riteneva che l'acqua favorisse e accrescesse la secrezione lattea nelle puerpere.

Also known as Fonte delle Sese, it dates back to the nineteenth century and in the past it was frequented mainly by local women, who used to bathe their breasts and make votive offerings, because water was believed to favor and increase milky secretion in women who had just given birth.
